Eligibility is limited to those working in San Francisco, Contra Costa and Alameda counties.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Academic excellence should be judged by:

- a. Record of high-impact scholarly contributions to the field of psychiatry.
- b. University service.
- c. Community service.
- d. Regional, national, or international prominence.

Community excellence should be judged by:

- a. Evidence of service to the local, state or national community.
- b. Evidence of teaching excellence.
- c. Evidence of original, creative contributions to the field.
- e. The general esteem and aspect of the candidate's peers as a role model and mentor to others in the field.
